### What is Church all about?

#### Get Talking

- 1. What are some of the views that people have when they hear the word "church" today?
- 2. What lasting impacts (good or bad) do you think the COVID pandemic might have had on how people think about church?

#### Investigate – The Origin of the Church

- 3. Read Exodus 19:1-6. Describe what's going on. Who is there? How did they get there? Why are they there?
- 4. Why is this such a significant moment in the story of the bible? How does it relate to God's original design for his world?
- 5. The bible looks back at this moment as "the day of the assembly" (literally: "the day of the church") e.g. Dt. 4:10; 9:10; 10:4 and 18:16 (also see Acts 7:38). If this is the birth place of the church, what we do we learn about the essence of church from this scene?
- 6. Read a bit further in Exodus 19:9-22. What was it like being there at that "church"? Why? (See also 20:18-19)

Investigate – The Wonder of the Church

- 7. Read Hebrews 12:18-24. What is the writer talking about here? What contrast is being made?
- 8. The contrast (v22-24) with that first mountain gathering couldn't be more striking. What is this second gathering like?
- 9. When is all of this happening? Why do you say so?
- 10. Who are these people gathered around? Why are they able to be so joyful?
- 11. If this is true of God's people whenever they gather, how should it change the way we see our own church gatherings?

#### Investigate – The Response of the Church

- 12. Read Hebrews 12:25-29. What is the right response once we understand the significance of the gathered church?
- 13. How should all of this shape our own worship (see v28-29)? How might this look in practical terms? What would it look like to worship God with a sense of his awesomeness?
