- 4. What is the unbelieving world like, according to 4:17-19? What causes this?
- 5. How do we see evidence of this ungodliness in the culture around us?
- 6. By contrast, how does Paul describe the change that God has brought about in his people (4:20-21)? What has God done?

What do we still need to do (4:22-24)? What does this actually mean? 7. "Put on the new self" (4:24) is very different to "try harder" or "pull 8. yourself together".
