- 1. What do we learn about Luke's method, audience and purpose from the opening paragraph of this book (1:1-4)?
- 2. Scan through the opening chapter what are some of the big moments and events that unfold?
- 3. What's really going on in this chapter and why is that significant? (Hint: the two songs help us to interpret what is happening)?
- 4. What do we learn about Zechariah and Elizabeth's circumstances (v5-7)?
- 5. How does God supernaturally interrupt their lives? What are they told about their future son (v11-17)?
- 6. Why did Zechariah lose his speech (v18-20)? How is this different to Mary's response to the angel (v34-37)? (See also v45)
- What do we learn about Mary, her background and her circumstances (v26-27)?

- 8. What is Mary told about her future son? What is the significance of this in light of the bigger story of the bible (see, for example, 2 Samuel 7:8-16)?
- 9. What reason does the angel give Mary as to why she should believe what she has been told? What promises of God do you find hardest to believe?
- 10. What is Mary's song about (v46-55)? Try to pick out the main themes.
- 11. What is Zechariah's song about (v67-79)?
- 12. What do v68-75 say God is rescuing his people *from*? What do they say he is rescuing them *for*?
- 13. Why is John important in the bigger plans of God (see Malachi 3:1)?
- 14. What are some of the Old Testament promises and characters mentioned or alluded to in these two songs?
- 15. What is the main thing you have learnt from this chapter? How will this change your understanding of God and what He is doing?
