READ Ephesians 4:1-6

- What is the calling that Paul urges the church to live up to? cf. Ephesians 1:3-14, 2:11-22
- 3. How is the church to conduct themselves in light of such oneness?
- 4. What example of perfect unity and relationships does Paul remind the church of in vs4-6? How is the church to reflect this?
- 5. Paul's reference to *unity* in verses 3 and 13 sounds contradictory. In light of the gospel and chapters 1-3, why is this not the case? What does Paul mean in each of these verses?

READ Ephesians 4:7-13

- 6. Would you say *uniformity* or *unity* is more important for the church? Give a reason and an example for your answer.
- 7. Why is diversity crucial within the church? How do you relate to others in light of this?
- 8. Which forms of Word Ministry does Paul list in these verses? Why do you think they are important for unity within the church?
- 9. What key role does community play with regard to church unity?

READ Ephesians 4:14-16

- 10. What danger is the church safeguarded against through maintaining unity?
- 11. What is the result of church unity?
- 12. Paul mentions *love* at the beginning and end of Ephesians 4:1-16. Why the emphasis on love? How does this play out in light of our Vision statement at Emmanuel Church and the unity we are to keep? Think practically.
